"Thy will be done on earth as it is in Heaven."



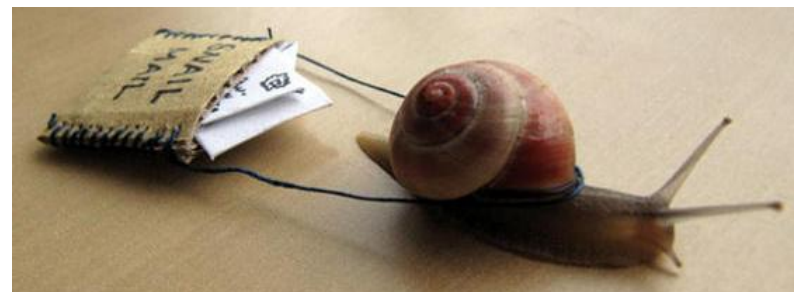
+++++ **Central/West Auckland Joy services for 2014** +++++

13 July, 10 August, 14 September, 12 October, 9 November [the last service for 2014, a special service].

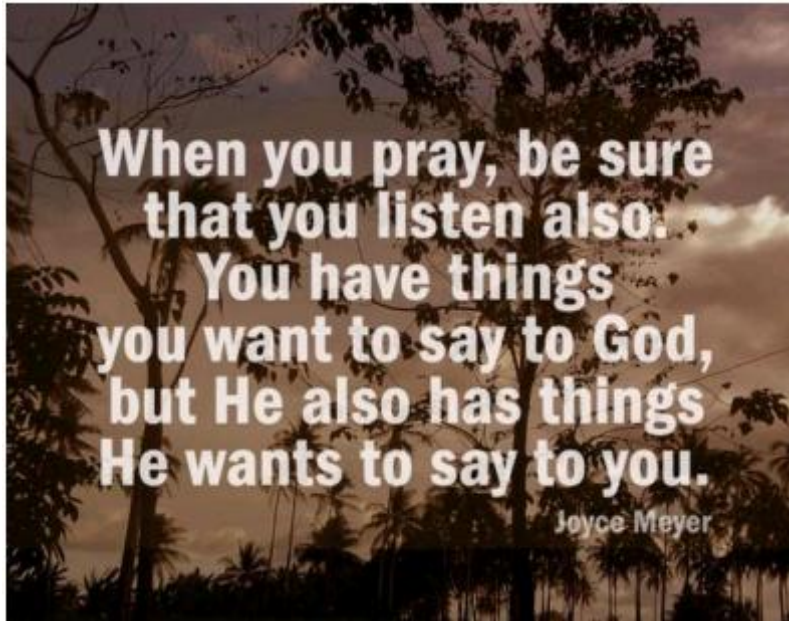
+++++ **Do you live at a different address?** +++++
