# Vodafone to cancel email

Vodafone will axe its email services in a move that will impact up to 250,000 customers. Vodafone will turn off its email accounts, including Clear and Paradise accounts, on November 30 and will instead encourage customers to set up free email accounts with either Google or Microsoft. The decision follows months of problems with high levels of spam and delayed mail. Vodafone consumer director Matt Williams said customers had told Vodafone its email service was no longer delivering the sort of experience they needed. Customers would receive an email from Vodafone providing support to set up an alternative.
