



It is an opportunity to be **intentional** about disability awareness and is a great way to **educate your Church**.




It is not just about raising awareness, but **celebrating** and **encouraging** people with disabilities in their **gifts** and **ministries**.

+++++ "Thinking Aloud" ["Thinking Allowed"] +++++++

This year, we are looking at "Who does God say who I am?"

The previous 2 months, we have looked at these 2 Bible verses:



If we are God's children, then we are this heirs also: heirs of God and fellow heirs of Christ; Romans 8:17

After I [Malcolm Dixon] spoke on Romans 8:17, and what we receive from God, as an HEIR,

Val O'Gorman said to me:

"But it's all about RELATIONSHIP".



Over the past month, I have done a total re-think.

It's about a **RELATIONSHIP** that's been restored ... between God and mankind, made possible by what Jesus did on the cross. That fellowship was broken in "**The Garden of Eden**", when the "**Forbidden Fruit**" was eaten by Adam and Eve [read it in **Genesis 3:1–24**].

It's interesting how many times I have come across this, in my regular Bible reading ["Quiet Time"].

John 10 is titled: "The Good Shepherd and His Sheep".

John 10: 2–5 [NLT]: [2] But the one who enters through the gate is the shepherd of the sheep. [3] The gatekeeper opens the gate for him, and the sheep recognize his voice and come to him. He calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. [4] After he has gathered his own flock, he walks ahead of them, and they follow him because they know his voice. [5] They won't follow a stranger; they will run from him because they don't know his voice."

John 10:14: "I am the Good Shepherd; I know My own sheep, and they know Me,

John 10:16: I have other sheep, too, that are not in this sheepfold. I must bring them also. They will listen to My voice, and there will be one flock with one Shepherd.

John 10:26–27: [26] But you don't believe Me because you are not My sheep. [27] My sheep listen to My voice; I know them, and they follow Me.

Jesus gives hard words in **Matthew 7:21–23 [NLT]**:

[21] "Not everyone who calls out to Me, 'Lord! Lord!' will enter the Kingdom of Heaven. Only those who actually do the will of My Father in heaven will enter. [22] On judgment day many will say to Me, 'Lord! Lord! We prophesied in Your Name and cast out demons in Your Name and performed many miracles in Your Name.' [23] But I will reply, 'I never knew you. Get away from me, you who break God's laws.'

Jesus Visits Martha and Mary

Luke 10:38–42 (NLT): [38] As Jesus and the disciples continued on their way to Jerusalem, they came to a certain village where a woman named Martha welcomed Him into her home. [39] Her sister, Mary, sat at the Lord's feet, listening to what He taught. [40] But Martha was distracted by the big dinner she was preparing. She came to Jesus and said, "Lord, doesn't it seem unfair to You that my sister just sits here while I do all the work? Tell her to come and help me."

[41] But the Lord said to her, "My dear Martha, you are worried and upset over all these details!
[42] There is only one thing worth being concerned about. Mary has discovered it, and it will not be taken away from her."

- Choose a quiet place
- Sit in His presence
- Read The Bible regularly ["His Living Word" to us] ...
 especially the words of Jesus [Matthew, Mark, Luke, John]
- Pray regularly [mostly listening to God]
