[11] Here there is no Gentile or Jew, circumcised or uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave or free, but Christ is all, and is in all. [12] Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, <u>CLOTHE</u> <u>YOURSELVES</u> with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. [13] Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. [14] And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity.

[13] Therefore put on the FULL ARMOUR of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. [14] Stand firm then, with the BELT of truth buckled round your waist, with the BREASTPLATE of righteousness in place, [15] and with your FEET fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. [16] In addition to all this, take up the SHIELD of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. [17] Take the HELMET of Salvation and the SWORD of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

[18] And <u>PRAY</u> in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on <u>PRAYING</u> for all the Lord's people. **[19]** <u>PRAY</u> also for me, that whenever I speak, words may be given me so that I will fearlessly make known the mystery of the gospel, **[20]** for which I am an ambassador in chains. <u>PRAY</u> that I may declare it fearlessly, as I should.
